○ Check-In

At Check-In, the teams will receive their information packets, t-shirts, bags, water bottles, and lanyards with their name badges. ○ Food Trucks

Cost of food at Aesthetics is not covered by the registration fee. However, food trucks will be at Aesthetics, and payment can be made at each truck.

○ Aesthetics Opening Remarks

Teams must have their bridges set up by approximately 2 pm. Close to 2:15 pm, everyone will be asked to gather on the SIU Arena steps for Opening Remarks. At the conclusion of Opening Remarks, a group photo will be taken by a drone.
